Dear Parents/Care Givers,

The Faculty and Staff welcome you to Most Holy Trinity School for the 2009-2010 school year! We hope you have had a safe and relaxing summer.

We have many new changes to announce for this school year. We welcome our new first grade teacher, **Ms. Tiffany Willette**, to our faculty. Many of our students already know her since she subbed at various times in our building last year. We are pleased to have her with us and assure you that that you and your children can look forward to a continuation of the excellent education we have always offered. We are also celebrating achievement in our Iowa Test Scores MHT ranked in the top 15% of the nation!

We are also pleased to introduce a **seventh grade** class this year as part of our expansion into the former medical clinic space. We will offer 8th grade in 2010-2011. In addition, all the windows in the school have been replaced which gives us a new, contemporary look and will save energy. **Our school offices have moved over to the 6th Street side and our main entrance will now be through the green doors marked #1.**

Enclosed you will find the 2009-2010 school calendar. Also the Covenant form and tuition payment schedule. Please sign these forms and return to the office. More detailed monthly calendars and lunch menus will be available on our website as well as through the office. Teachers will distribute class lists the first day of class. **You do not have to spend money for school supplies!** Through the generosity of several suburban parish groups Most Holy Trinity School receives an abundance of school supplies which we will give to the children when school begins.

Classes begin on **Tuesday, September 8th**. Kindergarten through 7th Grade students will gather in the cafeteria *promptly at 8:00am*, while Pre-School Montessori will join Mrs. Brown in her classroom.

We will have a **12 noon dismissal. Lunch will be served, but there will be No Latchkey. Our regular schedule will start on Wednesday, Sept. 9th at 8:00am until 3:15pm. Breakfast and lunch will be served and latchkey begins.**

Dress Code begins on September 8th. Please remember that this includes slacks/skirts that are navy blue, khaki or black. Uniform shorts of dress code colors may be worn if they are knee-length and appropriate for school. Shirts/blouses need to be solid color of light blue, navy blue, or white. T-shirts worn underneath shirts must be white or light grey only. For safety reasons, no open-toed sandals can be worn at school.

Registration fees must be paid before September 8th and tuition payments begin the first day of school. Student weapon sheets, internet safety agreement, and use of student picture sheets will be passed out in the classrooms. **These documents need to be signed and returned to the teacher so please be sure to look for them, complete them and have your child bring them back to their teacher.**

I look forward to seeing each and every one of you and to another year of exciting learning, interesting challenges, and many memorable events. Please enjoy the rest of the summer and come back to us safely.
