The stores are already introducing their back-to-school items so it seems appropriate to think about the coming school year even if the calendar says it is only the middle of July. As a reminder: You do not have to spend money for a lot of school supplies! Through the generosity of several suburban parish groups Most Holy Trinity School receives an abundance of school supplies which the children will receive when classes begin.

I am pleased to announce that we are starting a program that many of our families have requested, called FACTS. This program is for tuition collection that will assist families meet their financial obligations in a simple, convenient way this is completely confidential and secure. FACTS is the payment plan provider most widely used by other schools in the Archdiocese of Detroit. It is not a loan program so FACTS does not assess any interest or finance charges, and there is no credit check. This program will help Most Holy Trinity School to more efficiently manage tuition collection while offering you convenience. Most people now pay their utility and credit card bills electronically and FACTS functions in the same manner. Your monthly tuition payment will automatically be deducted from your bank account on your choice of dates. By using this program we will be better able to control our costs and allow us to focus more on the quality education MHT students receive.

Getting started is easy! There is a direct link on our website which will allow you to enroll in this program simply by clicking on the "Get Started" button under "New User". Enter student information for EACH student on the agreement. Select a payment plan option. Enter the proper demographic information and create a username and password. After entering financial account information for making payments there will be time to review your account summary and click the "submit" button. Choose to print or email your confirmation page. It includes your agreement number which you will need in order to reference your tuition payment plan with us and FACTS. You will find this is the same procedure used for any electronic payments.

This year we will also sign an individual tuition agreement with each family in order to clarify the amount of payments and the other options you have for paying your tuition. By initiating these two new items we hope to streamline the business side of running the excellent educational program we strive to provide for your children.

I look forward to seeing each one of you and to another year of exciting learning, interesting challenges, and many memorable events. Please enjoy the rest of the summer and come back to us safely.
