

## Most Holy Trinity School Dress code

Slacks, skirts, jumpers, skorts – **navy blue, khaki (tan) or black.**

Shirts, blouses – **solid colors: white , light blue, navy blue, or forest green (dark).**

**Shirts need to have a collar or turtleneck – no T-shirts!**

School polo shirts with the Most Holy Trinity logo are always appropriate and are available in the office for \$15 each. School uniform shorts may be worn in warm weather.

School sweatshirts and hoodies are also available in the office. Sweatshirts cost \$18 and hoodies are \$20.

Shoes - Tennis shoes are appropriate, but **no flip-flop sandals**. They are not safe or healthy in a school setting. Regular sandals are fine.

Every Friday students may dress in casual wear, if they wish, for .50 cents. No sagging pants or apparel that does not cover the midriff is allowed at any time. Tank tops, halter tops, or spaghetti straps are not appropriate. There should be a distinction between clothing worn to school and that which is worn for casual occasions at home.

In order for the school to run smoothly it is necessary to maintain an atmosphere in which real learning can occur. Therefore, students are **NOT allowed to carry cell phones during school hours.** If you wish your child to have a cell phone for after-school use **the phone needs to be turned into the office or given to the teacher when they arrive at school and it will be returned at the end of the day.**

**Electronic toys, Game Boys, CD players, Yugio cards or anything that can be a distraction from the educational process are NOT permitted in school.**
